The Arizona Daily Star Sportsmen's Fund raises money so children from low-income households and military families can attend summer camp at little or no cost to their families.

Since 1947, the Sportsmen's Fund has helped pay for 44,033 children to go to camp. We're one of the oldest 501(c)(3) charities in Arizona and one of the most efficient, with 97 cents from every dollar going to send kids to camp.

We send local kids to weeklong YMCA, Boy Scout and Girl Scout overnight camps, as well as overnight camping at Camp Tatiyee for schoolage children and teens with special needs.

So far, we've received 915 donations totaling \$186,915 and bills totaling \$207,490 for 539 campers.

We hope to make our deficit with our long-time fundraiser, The Cork Fun Chili Cook Off, on Saturday, Oct. 14, at The Cork Tucson, 6320 E. Tanque Verde Road, from noon to 2 p.m.

Local restaurants donate their best chili — most imagined specifically for the event — for the public to sample and judge. Tickets at the door are \$10.

Restaurants scheduled to cook are The Cork Tucson, Casino del Sol, Eclectic Cafe, Saddlehorn Saloon, The Barnyard, Noble Hops, Brushfire BBQ, Canyon's Crown, Fini's Landing, Fire Truck Brewing Co. and Flora's Market Run.

This is our 19th Chili Cook Off. Last year we raised \$25,463. To date we have raised \$262,593.
